

Goonhillend

History and construction

Formerly two cottages probably dating back to the early to mid 1800's. Goonhillend was purchased by the current owners in 1976 in semi derelict state and was renovated and extended at that time. Construction is of local stone with the rear lounge extension being concrete and Thermalite block. The roof of both the house and the garage are reclaimed Delabole slate (about half of which came from Redruth's Flower Pot Chapel). The main concrete floor slab is laid on polystyrene sheets for better insulation. Council tax band D. Mains water and electricity. Septic tank drainage.
